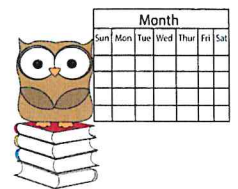

Student Art Competition

The City of Bellflower invites 3rd - 6th grade students as of the 2023-24 school year to participate in a Student Art Competition on Saturday, May 4, 2024, at Simms Park Auditorium, 16614 S. Clark Avenue. Participants must either be 1) a resident of the City of Bellflower, or 2) a student at any school within Bellflower city limits, or 3) attending a school that serves Bellflower residents (Esther Lindstrom, ILC, Stephen Foster, Valley Christian). Participants must pre-register by visiting the Parks & Recreation page of the city's website at www.bellflower.org. Walk-in registration is also accepted at Caruthers, Simms or Thompson Park, during regular park hours.

Registration will close on Thursday, April 18, 2024. Students may choose to provide their own art materials (crayons, water color paints and/or colored pencils only) and/or the city will provide crayons, water color paints and/or colored pencils to any participant upon request.

Mixed media paper will be provided and will be the only paper students are allowed to use. Students requiring an easel must provide their own. Students are not allowed to receive assistance during the competition.

The following art subjects will be assigned to each grade level:

3rd Grade – Under Water Adventure

4th Grade – The Great Outdoors

5th Grade – Imaginary World

6th Grade – City of Bellflower Community

Students may create paintings, drawings or collages within these themes and are encouraged to practice in advance. Art projects must begin from scratch on the day of the competition. 3rd & 4th grades will have 45 minutes to complete their art. 5th & 6th grades will have one hour to complete their art. Art will be judged based on creativity, quality, clarity, and overall presentation. 1st place for each grade level will receive a trophy and their artwork will be exhibited at Bellflower City Hall until 5/28/24. 2nd and 3rd place in each grade level will receive a medal. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
